Welcome back to the start of our summer term when we have lots of interesting events happening! Our topics this term are focused on our local area, including Anglo-Saxons and Castles! Our younger children will be looking at castles, fairy tales and fantasy, while our older children will be looking as castles as parts of settlements and why they were built.

We are also approaching the main assessment period in the school year and so attendance, always important, is particularly so in May, to avoid children missing activities and so having to catch up later.

Forest School

Now we are into the warmer weather (hopefully!), we are going to make the most of our outdoor learning areas. From <u>Tuesday 19th April</u> we will be Forest Schooling each Tuesday afternoon, with the younger children in Class 1 also working outside in our Forest School on a Thursday morning, beginning on <u>Thursday 14th April</u>. We hope that the need for hats and gloves will be replaced by the need for sunhats and sun cream, although as always our weather is unpredictable, so please make sure children are prepared for all weathers!

Tennis

Children need navy blue shorts, white t-shirts and trainers, and are welcome to wear a fleece or sweatshirt while the weather is cool. Even at this time of year there is heat in the sun, and so we ask that all children have a sunhat and sun cream in school for protection at all times.

Uniform and PE kits

The uniform orders have arrived in school and will be sent home today. Please remember that the First School uniform can be warn for as long as it still fits your child, we are not asking everyone to have the new primary logo on their clothing for September. And likewise, any new uniform that is ordered will have the 'Primary' logo, and so can be worn while we are still officially a First School, in the lead up to the age range change in September.

Breamish Valley Nursery Consultation

The outcome of our nursery consultation was shared with parents via email over the Easter break. The outcome is that Breamish Valley Nursery will now be the maintained nursery for Branton Community First School, and we have retained our Community Powers so that we can continue to offer up to 30 hours of Early Year provision for rising 3s, 3 and 4 year olds. We also offer a 2 Year Old session on a Wednesday afternoon so that children can come and socialise in our setting once they are 2 years old.
