Mathematics - Counting

- 1-1 principle, assigning one number name to each object that is being counted.
- Stable order principle, numbers have to be said in a certain order
- Cardinal principle, the number name assigned to the final object in a group is the total number.
- Abstract principle, anything can be counted, including things that cannot be touched including sounds, movements etc..

Plus - Sorting into groups, comparing quantities, one more, one less, and 'My Day', comparisons of length, height, weight.
