

# SUMMER CLUB NEWSLETTER

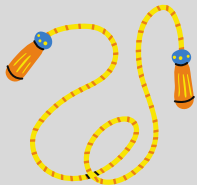


Week 1- 28<sup>th</sup> July



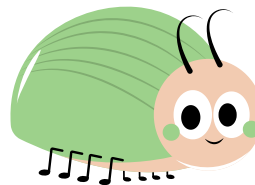
