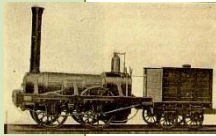

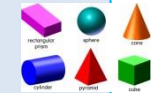


## Mathematics

- Direct comparisons and mathematical language more, less, fewer, taller/ shorter, heavier /lighter etc.
- Talking about / sorting coins (nursery) and recognising coins (Rec)
